





## #1: RIGHT TO APPEAL

You have the right to appeal an unfavorable decision.

You have 60 days from the date of the decision to appeal.



### #2: WORKING WHILE ON SSI

You have the right to work while receiving SSI up to an annual limit. But, you must report that income to the Social Security Administration.

You should keep proof that you reported the income!



#### #3: RIGHT TO ACCESS YOUR FILE

You have the right to examine your Social Security Administration file.

You can go to your local Social Security office and request access to your file.



#### #4: OVERPAYMENTS

If you have been notified that you have an overpayment, you have the right to appeal. You have 60 days to appeal.

You also have the right to ask for a waiver. There is no deadline to ask for a waiver.



#### #5: MAILING OF NOTICES

If you are homeless, you have the right to ask that your notices be mailed to a safe address.



#### #6: ELIGIBILITY

# You may be eligible for Social Security if you are:

- aged 62 or older,
- disabled, OR
- the child or spouse of someone who gets
  Social Security
  benefits.
